



CCASA All-Star Team Registration Information rev. - 01/21/15

No team will be allowed to participate in any tournament until their team has been registered and approved by their respective District JO Commissioner.

ID card Requirement – Each adult in the dugout or on the field is required to have a current photo ID card that shows a clear background check. ID cards are obtained through the team's respective league. The ID card **MUST** be worn around the neck and visible at all team functions. ID card lanyards can be obtained by contacting jessica.ralls@centralcalasa.com

ACE Requirement – CCASA is requiring that each team have one adult ACE certified. The one adult requirement will be enforced at the Association Championships. ACE can be obtained by logging on to RegisterASA.com web site after coaches have been registered by their league. Assistance with ACE should be directed to jessica.ralls@centralcalasa.com

Classification Policy – All CCASA Summer All-Star teams shall be classified "B" unless the team meets one of the following two criteria to be eligible to participate in the "C" Tournament Program:

- A. Teams formed from a league with four or less teams within the same age classification.
- B. A second team formed from a league. Note: The second team must be made up of "second tier players" that tried out for the first team and were not selected (players cannot select to play for the second team).

A team will be classified at time of team registration. Once a team's classification has been set there will be no reclassifications. Exception - the only teams subject to reclassification are "C" teams from leagues with 9 or more teams in that age classification.

8U Team Information – All 8U teams are considered unclassified and can play in either "B" or "C" tournaments. Teams should also be aware that all tournaments will use adopted 8U rules. Rules can be viewed at www.centralcalasa.com
